<u>UAC Deferring A Uni Course - What you need to do.</u> How do I defer?

When you receive an offer to enrol in a course, information included with your offer will explain how to apply for deferment. You may have to accept the offer before you can defer. Most institutions will ask you to provide a statement to explain why you wish to defer and what you will be doing during this period. Once your deferment has been granted, you will receive written confirmation of your deferment from the institution concerned. This will also give instructions on how to take up your deferred course. If, at the end of the deferment period, you decide you would like to be considered for other courses, you can complete a new UAC application and include these course preferences. If you receive an offer to one of the new courses, you can then decide whether to accept the offer or take up your deferred course.

Can my offer lapse?

Yes. If you undertake degree studies or certain levels of TAFE study other than NSW HSC courses during your deferment period, your offer at many institutions will lapse.
